EastendHomes appointed Leaside Regeneration to prepare and submit a planning application for works to refurbish their 613 existing dwellings on the Eric and Treby Estate, and to develop an additional 209 new homes containing studios, 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 bedroom units; a new community centre and a new Housing Estate Management Office. The scheme also required Conservation Area Consent for the redevelopment to provide large, family homes on Brokesley Street.

In addition, Leaside coordinated extensive consultation with the estates residents and led pre-application negotiations with the London Borough of Tower Hamlets.

In addition to the above works, the scheme will introduce the complete upgrading of the gardens, communal spaces and childrens' play spaces across the estate. Following planning permission, work has started on site.
